- a. Report on closed Session-No report
- b. Approval of minutes of September 26 meeting. Motion made by Novak to approve minutes. Seconded by Schaiman. Abstention by Cho. Remote approval by Brown. September minutes approved and moved into record.
- c. Acceptance of reports of expenses for Period 2 (August) FY2024-25. Currently under budget as we wait for an annual payment to clear.  - Shawn Chaves began full time work as Librarian I. Very helpful to have extra person that speaks Spanish. He is getting trained on various legal procedures that impact library patrons. Probationary period ends May 1, 2025
 - Charges to library from county for HR and ISD services at \$200 an hour
 - Annual Report submitted end of October. Changes to report recommended by Novak regarding removal or rewording of Covid references in comparison to current data. Board recommends sending amendment with changes.
 - Discussed north county court feasibility and current public demand. Novak offered that Civil Judges will be moving up to north county.
 - Dissomaster to be discontinued
 - New AT&T Air to be up by end of November. Supposed to make use of fiberoptic capabilities
